Any complaints or issues should be raised by members with a Hastings U3A Committee member and should receive prompt and fair resolution.

Members should:

- · Participate in a friendly, positive, honest and ethical manner
- Show respect, courtesy and consideration to tutors, helpers and each other
- Avoid all forms of discriminatory behaviour
- Maintain appropriate privacy and confidentiality of other members' details
- Care for the property used by U3A and the possessions of others
- Use Hastings U3A resources in a proper manner and for a proper purpose
- Refrain from promoting a personal business or cause
- Notify their tutor/s if they will be absent from a class
- Wear their Hastings U3A Membership badge at all times when participating in U3A classes and activities
- Understand that if they fail to attend three or more consecutive classes without notifying their tutor of the reason for the absence, their enrolment in that class may be cancelled
- Understand that by enrolling they give Hastings U3A permission to call a medical attendant or ambulance in case of an emergency where the member is unable to give permission themselves. In such instances the member accepts liability for any costs that may be incurred
- Where possible assist with setting up/tidying away equipment for activities and courses
- Where possible volunteer time to assist in the running of Hastings U3A
